STATEWIDE	Counties may require travelers five and older to obtain a subsequent test after arrival into the State, which test shall be paid for and administered by the county at a county-designated site.	Misdemeanor punishable by \$5,000 fine and/or 1 year in jail
HAWAII COUNTY	No 14-day self-quarantine with negative COVID-19 from a State approved COVID-19 testing facility 72 hours prior to departure. Post-arrival test also available for travelers who do not provide a negative test result 72 hours prior to arrival. However, traveler(s) must self-quarantine until negative test results are received and verified. May break quarantine to get tested.	Misdemeanor punishable by \$5,000 fine and/or 1 year in jail
CITY & COUNTY OF HONOLULU	No 14-day self-quarantine required when arriving from a neighbor island	N/A
KAUAI COUNTY	No 14-day self-quarantine with negative COVID-19 from a State approved COVID-19 testing facility 72 hours prior to departure.	Misdemeanor punishable by \$5,000 fine and/or 1 year in jail

STATEWIDE	Mandatory 14-day self-quarantine; persons entering to perform critical infrastructure functions may be able to obtain a limited exemption to break self-quarantine when performing their critical infrastructure functions; or persons entering the state that provide written confirmation from a State approved COVID-19 testing facility of a negative test result from an observed test administered to the traveler within 72 hours from the final leg of departure beginning October 15, 2020. Japan was added as a Safe Travels Partner for flights starting on November 6, 2020, and	Misdemeanor punishable by \$5,000 fine and/or 1 year in jail

KAUAI COUNTY	No 14-day self-quarantine with negative COVID-19 from a State approved COVID-19 testing facility 72 hours prior to departure. Optional post-travel test available. Emergency Rule #19 also contains provision that if the 7-day average of daily COVID-19 cases on Kauai reaches 5 or more for one week, that the County shall submit a rule to rescind the negative test exemption for trans-Pacific travelers.
